PHILANTHROPIC GRANOLA COMPANY ANNOUNCES 37% INCREASE IN ANNUAL CHARITABLE GIVING LED BY NEW PARTNERSHIPS AND GROWING SALES

Longmeadow, MA – January 22, 2019 – Jeff's Granola announced today a 37% increase in annual charitable giving in 2018 totaling \$1,622. Founded as a social enterprise, Jeff's Granola employs a philanthropic business model to donate 100% of its after tax profits or 10% of its total annual revenue, whichever is more, to 501c-3 nonprofit organizations selected by its customers. Jeff's Granola offers a selection of gluten-free, organic and low-sugar granolas made from high-quality ingredients.

The increase was made possible by new partnerships, growing sales, and the introduction of the newest flavor, Crunchy Seeds and Oats, with less than 3 grams of sugar per ½ cup serving. One customer raved "The fact that it's not too sweet means it's perfect for me. I'm a new fan!" This year, Jeff's Granola teamed up with Big Y World Class Markets in Longmeadow and East Longmeadow, Massachusetts, to donate all in-store sales to <u>Survivor Journeys</u>, a community-based support network for cancer survivors. For the first time, Jeff's Granola was available on Amazon, bringing its product to a national audience. Jeff's Granola also debuted in its seventh retail location, Highland Park Market in Suffield, Connecticut, and continued a successful partnership with River Valley Co-op in Northampton, Massachusetts which resulted in its second annual large donation to <u>United Way of Hampshire County</u>.

"I am so grateful for the overwhelming support from our partners and customers, and the momentum going into 2019 is building," said Jeff's Granola Founder and CEO Jeff Greim. "I started this company to test out a socially conscious business model, and seeing it working is fabulous."
